Call him the king of collaborations. In addition to heading up his own label, Mark McNairy likes to partner with classic brands. A previous collaborator with Bass, The Bathing Ape and others, the designer is now gearing up for releases with Timberland, Eastland and Keds. "I get approached by quite a few people at this point, but I only do the ones that fit with my aesthetic," said the designer. His latest shoe with Keds, a reinvention of the classic Triumph style, has been a long time in the making. "When *Footwear News* interviewed me [in 2009], I said the Keds Triumph was my favorite sneaker, and someone from Keds read that and approached me about the collaboration," McNairy recalled. "But there were issues with the factories, the molds and not being able to produce that shoe at the moment. So I transferred the design into the [Pro-Keds] Royal CVO, and then [Keds] did the Booster. That was really cool and successful, and then they decided, 'Let's do the Triumph." McNairy's favorite sneaker drops on Aug. 1. By Jocelyn Anderson


